1. School Survey Results

- Jack says that we have not exactly filtered out 'spam' or destructive responses
- Collected Responses
 - Year 12
 - Late arrivals – as soon as term break
 - Year 13
 - Two weeks of study leave
 - Prom inviting people from other schools
 - Chartwells
 - From results it can be seen that (1 underpriced, 5 overpriced):
 - Most of the food are overpriced (School cafe: drinks, smoothies [rated 5])
 - Action: Council requires reports of:
 - Chartwells financial statistics and sales of each type of product
 - Most favoured type of food (reduce price specifically for popular food)
 - Action: Send representatives from SC to negotiate about the cafeteria prices
 - Involves primary's perspective (benefiting the school community as a whole)
 - Increasing prices over the years
 - Suggest to drop the price of most popular food type
 - Canteen coupons
 - Coupons distributed by student council instead of head of years – should be implemented earlier
 - Unit of \$5 is too small, we should perhaps increase the discount
 - Suggestion: stamp cards instead of coupons (e.g. *buy 10 get 1 free*)
 - Suggestion: Combination coupons (e.g. cookie + drink)
 - Let focus group know that we will distribute the coupons after break, before the issue of canteen price is solved
 - Discuss on the ways that the coupons can be distributed
 - Method of distribution should be decided by year group
